



Household Hazardous Waste Cleanup Day

Household Hazardous Waste Cleanup Day is an annual event sponsored by the City of Ridgeland. It is typically held on a Saturday in May from 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. During this event, residents may bring collectable items to Holmes Community College located at 412 W. Ridgeland Avenue.

Collectable items include electronics such as: computers, monitors, keyboards, printers, scanners, fax machines, copiers, telephones, cellular phones and televisions. Other items for collection include tires, propane, antifreeze, batteries, paint, automobile motor oil, herbicides, pesticides and flammable and corrosive chemicals.

Chemical containers may not be larger than 5 gallons or 50 pounds, and it is preferable that chemicals be in their original containers or clearly marked for identification purposes.

Collectible items are subject to change. Please check the community calendar, the city's website, e-mail news and local media to learn the date for this year's event.
