Ridgeland Police provide extra officers to retail areas

(Ridgeland, Mississippi – Dec. 11, 2013) Ridgeland Police are working to deter crime in all shopping areas of Ridgeland this holiday season. They started Christmas detail at Thanksgiving with a focus on safety and crime prevention. Extra roving officers are covering both retail and residential areas throughout the city. "This creates

an omnipresence of police where you never know when a patrol car will come around the corner," said Randy

Tyler, Assistant Police Chief.

The retail areas that are covered by extra officers include the Renaissance at Colony Park, Northpark Mall, Jackson Street/Olde Towne District, Township at Colony Park, Wal-Mart on Wheatley Street, as well as other

shopping centers and grocery stores. "In addition to the officers in marked patrol vehicles, there are also

officers utilizing unmarked vehicles," added Tyler. "There is also a duty station located at Northpark Mall."
